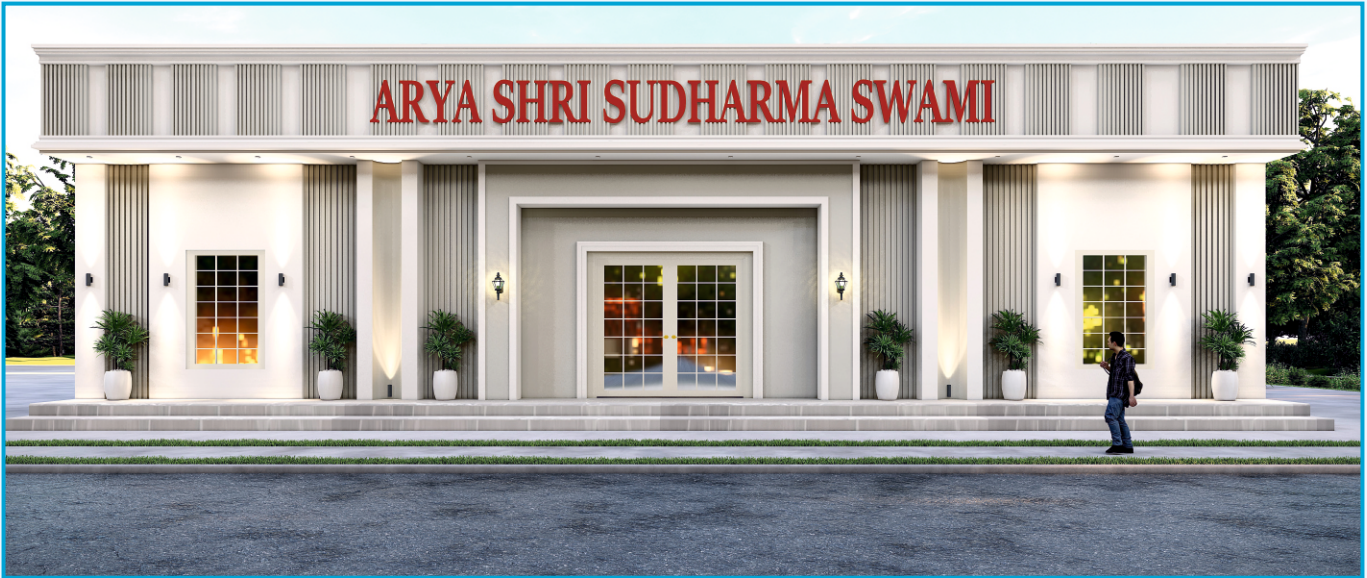
SENIOR SECONDARY WING (CLASSES XI-XII)

CURRICULUM & COURSE OF STUDY

PRE-PRIMARY CLASSES :-

The school follows the guidelines of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) in accordance with the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and National Curriculum Framework (NCF) 2023 the Foundational Stage**. The Pre-Primary curriculum is designed to ensure the holistic development of young learners through play-based, activity-oriented, and experiential learning methods.

KEY AREAS OF DEVELOPMENT :-

- **Language Development** – English & Hindi (listening, speaking, pre-reading, and pre-writing skills)
- **Early Mathematics Skills** – Number concepts, shapes, patterns and logical thinking
- **Environmental Awareness** – Understanding surroundings and basic life concepts
- **Creative Expression** – Art, craft, colouring, music, dance and dramatization
- **Physical Development** – Fine and gross motor skills through indoor and outdoor activities
- **Social & Emotional Development** – Good manners, sharing, cooperation and value education

Learning is imparted through storytelling, rhymes, games, hands-on activities and interactive sessions in a joyful, safe and nurturing environment. The aim is to build a strong foundation for formal schooling while fostering curiosity, confidence, creativity and a love for learning.

PRIMARY & MIDDLE CLASSES :- The school follows the curriculum prescribed by the **Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and National Curriculum Framework (NCF) 2023**. The academic programme focuses on conceptual clarity, skill development and the holistic growth of students.

- **PRIMARY CLASSES (I–V) :-** At the primary level, emphasis is laid on strengthening foundational skills and developing curiosity through activity-based and experiential learning.

Subjects Offered :- English, Hindi, Mathematics, Environmental Studies (EVS), Computer Education, General Knowledge | Art & Craft | Music | Physical Education Continuous assessment, project work and interactive classroom activities are conducted to ensure effective learning.

- **MIDDLE CLASSES (VI–VIII) :-** At the middle level, the curriculum becomes more structured and subject-oriented, encouraging analytical thinking and deeper understanding among Students.

Subjects Offered :- English, Hindi, Sanskrit/ Punjabi (as per school policy), Mathematics, Science, Social Science | Computer Science, General Knowledge, Art Education, Physical Education

Project-based learning, practical activities, periodic assessments and subject enrichment activities are conducted as per CBSE guidelines. The curriculum aims to prepare students academically while nurturing discipline, leadership qualities, creativity and strong moral values.

SENIOR CLASSES :- As per CBSE Guidelines The school follows the curriculum prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). The syllabus is designed to promote conceptual understanding, analytical thinking and practical application of knowledge.

- **SECONDARY LEVEL (IX & X) :-** The subjects offered include :- **English, Hindi/ Punjabi/ Sanskrit (Second Language), Mathematics (Standard/ Basic – as per CBSE norms), Science, Social Science, Information Technology, Computer Applications.** Internal assessments, practical work, subject enrichment activities and periodic tests are carried out as per CBSE examination guidelines.

- **SENIOR SECONDARY LEVEL (XI & XII) :-** Students may choose from the following streams (subject to availability):

◆ **SCIENCE STREAM :-** English Core, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/ Biology, Informatics Practices, Physical Education.

◆ **COMMERCE STREAM :-** English Core, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics | Mathematics/ Informatics Practices/ Physical Education.

◆ **HUMANITIES STREAM (Arts) :-** English Core, Political Science, History/ ECO, History, Sociology, Psychology, Physical Education/ Informatics Practices, Practical work, project-based learning and internal assessments are conducted as per CBSE guidelines. The curriculum aims at preparing students for higher education, competitive examinations and future career opportunities while nurturing values, discipline and leadership qualities.

EXAMINATION SCHEME

JUNIOR & SENIOR CLASSES :- (As per CBSE Guidelines) The school follows the examination pattern prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)

JUNIOR CLASSES (I–VIII) :- Assessment is conducted through a continuous and comprehensive evaluation system.

The evaluation includes :-

- Periodic Tests
- Notebook Submission
- Subject Enrichment Activities
- Half-Yearly Examination
- Annual Examination

Both scholastic and co-scholastic areas such as discipline, art, work education and physical education are assessed. The focus is on conceptual understanding, skill development and overall growth rather than rote learning.

SECONDARY & SENIOR SECONDARY CLASSES (IX–XII) :-

For Classes IX and X, The Assessment Is Conducted As Per Cbse Guidelines:

- Periodic Tests (Internal Assessment – 20 Marks)
- Multiple Assessment and Subject Enrichment
- Half-Yearly Examination
- Annual / Board Examination (80 Marks theory + Practical/Internal as applicable) For Classes XI and XII:
- Unit Tests
- Half-Yearly Examination
- Pre-Board Examination (for X and XII)
- Annual / Board Examination (as per CBSE pattern)

Practical examinations, project work and internal assessments are carried out in accordance with CBSE guidelines. The examination system aims to evaluate academic performance, practical skills, analytical ability and overall development of students.

EXAMINATION & ASSESSMENT SYSTEM :-

The school follows the examination and assessment pattern prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) in accordance with NEP 2020 guidelines. Assessment is conducted through:

- Periodic Tests
- Subject Enrichment Activities
- Notebook Evaluation
- Half-Yearly Examination
- Annual Examination

For Pre-Primary Classes, no formal written examinations are conducted. Assessment is continuous and based on observation and overall development.

ADMISSION PROCESS :-

- Students are admitted at the beginning of the academic session.
- At the time of admission, students may be required to appear for an entrance test in Language and Mathematics.

- Date of Birth Certificate
- Original School Leaving Certificate
- Recent passport-size coloured photographs of the child
- Original mark sheet of the last attended school
- Character Certificate (for senior classes)

- **Girls (Pre-Nursery to Class XII) :-** White Skirt, House T-Shirt, Belt with Stripes and White Hair Ribbons
